Includes

- All white, colored and coated papers
- Correspondence papers (letterhead, direct mail pieces and advertising)
- Magazines and catalogs
- Newspapers and inserts
- Brochures and pamphlets
- Envelopes (even with plastic windows or labels)
- Folders (manila, coated or colored)
- Manuals with glued bindings
- Paper from legal pads, steno pads, note pads
- Posters
- Receipts
- Scratch, message and memo pads
- Self-adhesive notes
- Soft-covered books
- Paperback books
- Frozen food boxes
- Paper items containing paper clips, rubber bands, staples, tape, post-its, plastic tabs or spiral bindings

Excludes

- Food-contaminated papers
- Restroom papers
- Papers containing synthetic materials
